

Arlington National Cemetery Public Disclosure Consent Form

The United States Army operates Arlington National Cemetery and the public has a right to information concerning requests for exception to burial policy. Therefore all parties requesting an exception for those persons who are not otherwise eligible for interment or inurnment in Arlington National Cemetery must consent to the release of the following information: the request submitted, to include the name of the requestor and the name of the person for whom the request for an exception was made, and the decision by the Army on that request.

Failure of the requestor to sign, notarize and return this document will prevent Arlington National Cemetery from processing the request for an exception.

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

GENERAL: This notice is provided pursuant to Public Law 93-579, Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. Section 552a, for individuals supplying information in order to request an exception to burial policy at Arlington National Cemetery.

EFFECTS OF NON-DISCLOSURE: Disclosure is Voluntary. However, failure to provide all the requested information will not allow processing of the Exception to Burial Policy request.
