SUBJECT: National Historic Preservation Act Section 106 for the Road Reconstruction & Sidewalk Improvement Project at Schley, Sherman, & Meigs Drives on the Grounds of Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington, Virginia (DHR Project No. 2024-4750)

Army National Military Cemeteries (ANMC) proposes a road reconstruction and sidewalk improvement project within Arlington National Cemetery (ANC) to improve safety and enhance the quality of the vehicular and pedestrian experience through a full-depth roadway reconstruction and realignment, and the construction of a new sidewalk along one side of Sherman Drive. The proposed project is considered a federal undertaking with the potential to cause adverse effects on historic properties pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 800.3(a).

ANMC is coordinating the project design with the National Park Service (NPS) George Washington Memorial Parkway (GWMP) to reduce potential impacts to historic, archaeological, and tree resources on lands managed by both agencies. ANMC shall serve as the lead agency for the project with responsibility for all National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) compliance.

On 20 June 2024, the U.S. Commission of Fine Arts (CFA) reviewed and approved the project. On 29 August 2024, ANMC initiated the consultation process with the Virginia State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, 16 U.S.C. § 470f, and its implementing regulations, 36 C.F.R. Part 800.

With this notice, ANMC provides the public the opportunity to view materials submitted to the SHPO as part of the Section 106 compliance process for the proposed undertaking. The documentation accompanies this notice. It shows the area potentially affected by the proposed project, contains a project description, identification of potential consulting parties, lists the historic properties contributing to National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) which are in the area of potential effects, and the agency's findings of no adverse effects.

This notice initiates a 30-day comment period. During this period, ANMC invites review and comment from the public on this project.
