Arlington National Cemetery (ANC) plans to retain three prefabricated buildings used for one year as temporary offices during the rehabilitation of the Administration Building. The rehabilitation is nearing completion. We plan to keep the prefabricated buildings in their current location for up to ten years to provide offices during the construction of the Southern Expansion of the cemetery.

ANC invites review and comment from the public on this project. We do this in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and The Programmatic Agreement among Arlington National Cemetery, The Virginia State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation for the Operation, Maintenance, and Repair Activities at Arlington National Cemetery.

The document “Arlington National Cemetery, Modular Office Complex, Arlington, Virginia, Project Description, Area of Potential Effects, And Assessment of Effects” accompanies this notice. It describes the undertaking, shows the area affected by the project, contains annotated photographs of the area, and lists the historic properties contributing to National Register of Historic Places Historic Districts which are in the area of potential effects.

ANC’s Cultural Resource Manager assessed the effects of the proposed undertaking using the criteria of adverse effects (36 C.F.R. 800.5(a)(1)) and determined the project will have an Adverse Effect on the characteristics which qualify Arlington National Cemetery for listing in the National Register of Historic Place. .
