## Getting There

- Gates open at 8:00 a.m.

- [Parking](#) is limited. You may walk or take the free tram from outside the [Welcome Center](#).
- **Please arrive at the tram stop no later than 30 minutes prior to your flower-laying time slot.**
- [A government-issued photo ID is required for entrance into the cemetery.](#)
- No containers (glass or otherwise), wreaths, bouquets or rolling luggage are permitted.
- There are no public lockers or hold areas at the cemetery.

## At the Ceremony

- This event is [ADA-accessible](#) and stroller-friendly.
- You may bring your own flowers, but some will be distributed for free.
- **No selfies are permitted at the Tomb.**
- Interpretive talks will be given from the [Memorial Amphitheater](#) west steps (side closest to the [Mast of the Maine Memorial](#)) throughout the day.

## Related Programs and Activities, Nov. 9-10

- Tour our **Tomb centennial exhibits** in the [Welcome Center](#) and the [Display Room](#) of the Memorial Amphitheater. From 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., **ANC curators and historians will act as docents in the Display Room**, offering short talks at the top of each hour. **Masks required.**

- You must be on the procession route (inside the cemetery) **no later than 8:45 a.m.**
- The route is [ADA-accessible](#) and stroller-friendly.
- This event will take place rain or shine.
- Memorial Avenue and Eisenhower Drive will be closed for short periods of time to accommodate the procession.

## Public Access, Parking and Traffic Information: Nov. 9-11

- [All visitors must have a government-issued ID for access.](#) Cemetery entrances include:

- Ord and Weitzel Gate (pedestrians only)
- 123 Service Complex (pedestrians only)
- Old Post Chapel Gate (family pass holder vehicle access/general public pedestrian access)
- Memorial Ave (family pass holder vehicle access)

- Expect delays in and around the cemetery, to include road closures in the immediate areas.
