

WAA Quick FAQ ANC

- <u>Wreaths</u> Wreath placement starts at 0800. All trucks and wreaths are the same. You can pick up a wreath from any truck. Wreath are located at numerous locations throughout the Cemetery.
- <u>Screening</u> –The ANC gates Main Entrance, South
 Gate and Ord & Weitzel will open to the public at 8
 a.m. All volunteers must pass through the cemetery's
 security screening process before entering the
 cemetery. DoD ID Card holder only lanes are available.
- Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall

 Will be accessible to DoD ID card holders only; the sole entry point to the cemetery from JBM-HH will be the Old Post Chapel Gate.
- Opening Ceremony There will be a brief opening ceremony inside the cemetery at the McClellan Gate at 8:30 a.m. General wreath placement will also begin at this time with the exception of those trucks in vicinity of the opening ceremony. They will begin wreath placements no later than 9 a.m.

- <u>Welcome Center</u> Is closed during WAA and tentatively will reopen at approximately 1400hrs once all wreath trucks have safely been removed from ANC.
- <u>Tram service</u> Will resume at approximately 1400hrs once all wreath trucks have safely been removed from ANC.
- <u>Exits</u> See Map on reverse.
